Receiving a driver's license for the first time is an important event in the lives of most young people. Driving is a privilege which should be respected due to the tremendous responsibility involved. The instructors in our program are responsible for teaching safe driving skills and attitudes, as well as identifying those students who demonstrate that they are not ready to assume this responsibility.

We have enclosed information to help make certain that each student and their parents &/or guardians understand the expectations of the **Segment 1** driver education program offered by the Mt. Pleasant Public Schools. Please take a few minutes, to review with your son/daughter, these materials which summarize the schedule, procedures, and requirements for the **Segment 1** program. The classroom instructor will also review these materials during the first classroom session.

Successful completion of the **Segment 1** program will enable your son/daughter to apply for a Level 1 operator's license. Plan to attend one of the MANDATORY Parent Information Meeting listed below.

Two sessions of Segment I Driver Education will be offered during the the summer, 2008:

June 9-June 27      &      July 7- July 25

To be eligible for these sessions, a student must be *14 years 8 months of age prior to the start* of the session they plan to attend. Students applying will be ranked (oldest to youngest) for enrollment, session selection and class time. The enrollment for a session will be closed as maximums are reached. Students failing to meet the eligibility requirement established by the Mt. Pleasant School District will not be allowed to enroll in the Driver Education course. Those requirements are as described in the Mt. Pleasant Athletic Code.

Students interested in enrolling for the summer, 2008, should complete the registration form attached & return it to MPHS or West Intermediate School. **Registration forms are due April 30th & will be accepted until the class is full.** Any registration received after due date will be processed based on availability or will be placed on a waiting list.

The tuition for the Driver Education program will be \$275 for any high school student. This fee covers **ONLY** Segment One. (Segment 2 fee is \$10.) The fee is non-refundable after the student begins the program. **The fee must accompany the registration form.**

The enrollment list will be posted outside the MPHS Principal Office & Rm 424 on or before May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008. No information will be released before this time. A letter of assignment will also be sent home to each student along with a class schedule.
